

Thrive Behavioral Health

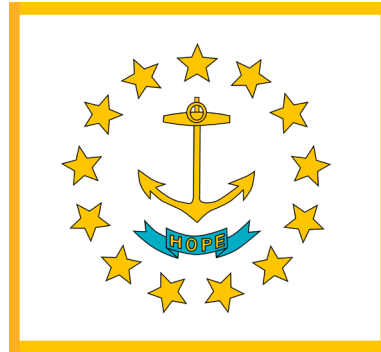
